



We are learning how to take care of babies. We washed them, dressed them, bundled them and packed diaper bags with items babies need.



We made fake playdough poop to put in the babies' diapers and cleaned & diapered babies.

We tried different flavors of baby food and made a graph showing which kinds of food they liked and disliked. Then children interpreted the information on the graph to find out how many people liked or didn't like each flavor of baby food.
