Pull a "whisker" from the side of your mouth.





SWIMSUIT (swim' soot'), n. (Swim clothes.) The

motions of swimming (usually the breast stroke) are made, followed by CLOTHES: both downturned

beach

Hold one arm flat and wave the other hand forward and back toward your arm, like waves hitting a beach.



castle n. A large building with thick walls and defenses against attack: the king's castle.

[large + house + the shape of a castle's turrets] Move both *L hands* from in front of each side of the chest, palms facing each other and index fingers

pointing forward, apart to each side in large arcs. Then, beginning with the fingertips of both open hands touching, palms angled toward each other, bring the hands downward at an angle to in front of each shoulder and then straight down, ending with the fingers pointing up and the palms facing each other. Then move both C hands, palms facing each other, up and down with alternating movements in front of each shoulder.







p a W hand on your chin twice.

ROCK 1 (rŏk), n. (The hardness is indicated by the striking of the fists.) The back of the right "S" hand is struck several times against the back of the left "S" hand. Cf. STONE 1.



WHALE 2, n. (The letter "W"; the movement.) The right "W" hand makes a series of undulating dive movements in front of the downturned left arm, which represents the surface of the water.





science Turn Open A hands upside down and circle them alternately, as if mixing chemicals.

water

lace the thumb with U fingers stended at the side of your rehead and bend fingers down.



boat

Cup your hands together like the shape of a boat and bounce them forward.
