

If You Give A Cat A Cupcake



cat

Pull a "whisker" from the side of your mouth.



Cupcake



clean

Slide one Open B hand along the palm of the other Open B hand.



hot

Twist a Bent 5 hand out from your mouth.



SWIMSUIT (swim' sōōt'), *n.* (Swim clothes.) The motions of swimming (usually the breast stroke) are made, followed by **CLOTHES**: both downturned "5" hands are posed with thumbs touching the chest. Both hands sweep down the chest repeatedly.

beach

Hold one arm flat and wave the other hand forward and back toward your arm, like waves hitting a beach.



castle *n.* A large building with thick walls and defenses against attack: *the king's castle.*

[large + house + the shape of a castle's turrets] Move both *L* hands from in front of each side of the chest, palms facing each other and index fingers pointing forward, apart to each side in large arcs. Then, beginning with the fingertips of both *open* hands touching, palms angled toward each other, bring the hands downward at an angle to in front of each shoulder and then straight down, ending with the fingers pointing up and the palms facing each other. Then move both *C* hands, palms facing each other, up and down with alternating movements in front of each shoulder.





ROCK 1 (rök), *n.* (The hardness is indicated by the striking of the fists.) The back of the right "S" hand is struck several times against the back of the left "S" hand. Cf. STONE 1.



boat

Cup your hands together like the shape of a boat and bounce them forward.



Water

Tap a W hand on your chin twice.



WHALE 2, *n.* (The letter "W"; the movement.) The right "W" hand makes a series of undulating dive movements in front of the downturned left arm, which represents the surface of the water.



Horse

Place the thumb with U fingers extended at the side of your forehead and bend fingers down.

science

Turn Open A hands upside down and circle them alternately, as if mixing chemicals.
