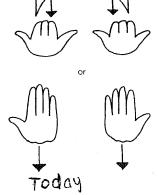
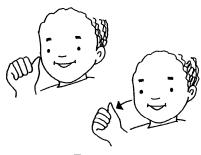

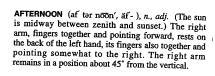


Morning Left arm flat in front with right arm lying on top. ight arm with open hand rises to upright position (sun rising in the sky).



Tomorrow

With a right "A" hand, thumb pointing up, move your hand forward from right cheek out a few inches from your face.







Yesterday

With a right "Y" hand, palm facing forward on the right side of your chin, make an arc backward toward your ear.



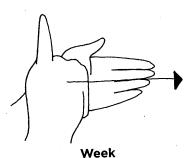
Night

With the left arm held horizontally, fingers down and flat hand pointing right, place the right forearm on the back of the left hand and move the right curved han downward (like the sun is setting).

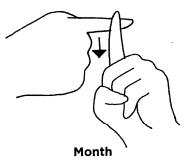


Day

The left arm is held horizontally pointing right with index finger extended. The right elbow rests on the left index finger and the right index finger points up. Move the right index finger in an arc from right to left (like the sun moving across the sky), until right index finger is touching the top of the left elbow.



Your left hand is held flat, fingers pointing away from your body. Move your right index finger forward across your left flat palm.

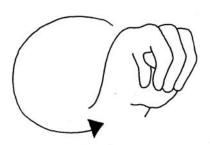


The left index finger is pointing up. The right inder finger begins at the top of left index finger and slid down the left finger from top to base.



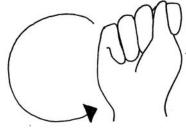
Sunday

th hands flat, palms forward, move at the same time in opposite directions making a circle.



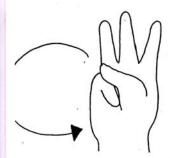
Monday

"T" hand makes a small clockwise circle.



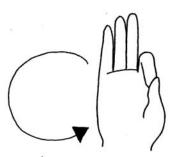
Wednesday

√" hand makes a small clockwise circle.



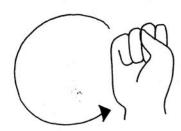
Thursday

Start with hand in "T" shape, then change to "H" and make a small clockwise circle.
