

# If You Give A Pig A Party



## party

Swing P hands back and forth.



## clothes/dress

Brush the thumbs of your Open B hands down your chest twice.



## friend

Link the index fingers of your X hands, then separate your hands, twist them around, and relink your index fingers.



## paper

Brush the heels of your palms together twice.



## balloon

Hold S hands at your mouth, one in front of the other, then move your hands out to the side as you open to C hands.

## dinner

Sign eat and then sign night.



## sleepover

Sign sleep and then sign party.



## game

Tap the knuckles of your Open A hands together.

### ice cream

Pretend to hold an ice cream cone at your mouth and brush it against your chin twice.



### book

Hold palms together and open them, like opening a book.



(tēl' ə fōn'), *n.*, *v.*, -PHONED, -PHONING.  
(The natural sign.) The right "Y" hand is placed at the right side of the head with the thumb touching the ear and the little finger touching the lips. This is the more modern telephone receiver. Cf. PHONE.



### home

Place the fingertips of a Flat O hand at your mouth, then move your hand back to the side of your face.



### house

Form the roof and sides of a house with your hands.
