ITEM TITLE	Garden Enrichment Instruct 25-26 SY
DISCUSSION NOTES	Andrea makes a motion to use undesignated tax credit funds. All three positions are at the current rate for SY 24-25. We have just under \$56,000. Miles will be left with about \$25,000 before securing more tax credit money. Garden enrichment teacher is being grandfathered in at \$20/hr; 5hrs/day for total of \$19,400 from Undesignated Funds. This is \$4.50 more than any other classified personnel.

ITEM TITLE	Sports Coordinator 25-26 SY
DISCUSSION NOTES	Andrea makes a motion to approve \$15.45/hr; 2 hrs/day for a total of \$2,434.92 for all four sports seasons. This position is responsible for collecting funds, ordering uniforms, keeping physicals on file, and any other important paperwork. As an administrator of 1 at Miles, it is impossible to manage these responsibilities because there is no assistant principal who would typically do these tasks, so we are approved for this position.
