The Napping House

For the month of August, the afternoon class explored color while reading The Napping House by Audrey and Don Wood. Students explored concepts of color through drawing and painting activities, sorting games, and yoga. Teachers supported by asking students to make predictions about how colors would mix and what the result would be. 8-2015



Students explore the concepts of colors and letter in the Rainbow names activity. Using a selection of different colors, students traced their name multiple times to create a rainbow effect.



Scientific fundamentals were explored in an oil, water, and color experiment. In a large clear container filled with water, students poured paint mixed with oil; teachers supported by asking student to make prediction about how the colors would mix.



Students participated in a sorting game focused on categorizing items by size, color, and shape. The game also focused on developing logical thinking and problem solving skills.



The afternoon class explored a retelling of the story through yoga and movement.
