


CRY (kri), v., CRIED, CRYING. (Tears streaming down the cheeks.) Both index fingers, in the "D" position, move down the cheeks, either once or several times. Sometimes one finger only is used. Cf. BAWL 1, TEAR 2, TEARDERS WITCH.

Tap S hands together.





Wave your right hand back and forth over your left forearm.



Hold palms together and open them, like opening a book.



library

Circle an L in the air.



CAFETERIA 1 (kaf' ə tir' ē ə), n. (The letter "C"; a restaurant.) The right "C" hand is placed at the left corner of the mouth and moves over to the right cor-



Playground

(plā), v., PLAYED, PLAYING. (Shaking tambourines.) The "Y" hands, held aloft, are shaken back and forth, pivoted at the wrists.





BUTTON v. phrase. (The buttons along the garment.) The right "F" hand describes the shape of the buttons as they are lined up on the chest, from waist to throat.





cool/fine

Place the thumb of a 5 hand on your chest and wiggle your fingers.



BERRY (ber' è), n. (A small item being picked off a branch.) The right fingertips grasp the tip of the left little finger and twist, as if plucking a berry. This sign is used for any berry, often with classifiers. Cf. CHERRY, VIRGIN 3.



red

Slide your index finger down your lips, ending with an X hand.



white

Place a Bent 5 hand on your chest, then pull it out while changing to a Flat O hand.



Slide a B hand down your cheek.



blue

Twist a B hand in front of your shoulder.



Place a 5 hand under your chin





WET (wet), adj., n., v., wer or werted, werting. (The wetness.) The right fingertips touch the lips, and then the fingers of both hands open and close against the thumbs a number of times. Cf. DAMP, MOIST.
